DESCRIPTION:

The intern will participate in a local dive trip to either test scuba gear, produce video or create a blog.

LOCATION and DURATION:

Located in Winter Park, Florida. Six weeks during the summer, with specific timing to be coordinated between the intern and the sponsor.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Open Water scuba certified not required, but strongly preferred
- Bachelor's degree in Journalism or candidate for a bachelor's degree in Journalism strongly preferred
- If you do not have a degree in Journalism, must have at least two of the following skills/experience:
 - Bachelor's degree in English with writing coursework (or candidate for this degree)
 - Bachelor's degree in Marine Biology, Marine Conservation or Marine Archaeology (or candidate for this degree) or coursework
 - Familiarity with online content management systems such as WordPress
 - Underwater research and/or marine conservation experience or previous internships
 - Photography experience
 - Working knowledge of Adobe Photoshop and/or InDesign

BUDGET:

A stipend is provided to help cover travel to/from site and related internship expenses. Housing is not provided.
